

6) Environmental Policy:

The Environmental Law Policy of M S College of Law represents a transdisciplinary discourse that integrates various fields, including Constitutional Law, International Law, Tort Law, Criminal Law, Human Rights, and Environmental Economics. This body of law encompasses a wide range of disciplines, providing a comprehensive and holistic framework for addressing environmental issues. The three fundamental principles that characterize this legal framework are: (i) the dismissal of the "Business as Usual" paradigm; (ii) a strong conviction in environmentally sustainable development; and (iii) a dedication to operational effectiveness and serving as a catalyst for an environmentally just legal system. In the B.LS./LL.,B LL.B & LLM program, Environmental Law and Policy is a mandatory core course designed as a natural progression from the Natural Resource Management (Land Laws) course. Since environmental law draws from multiple disciplines, both within and beyond the legal field, the course takes a transdisciplinary approach to offer students a holistic understanding of its context and purpose. Building on the principles of natural resource management, the course focuses on the foundational norms of environmental governance. While emphasizing Indian environmental law and policy, it also examines international influences and practices.

Set against the backdrop of the environmental crisis and global assessments of India's environmental performance, the course begins by exploring key theories of environmental management. It includes discussions on topics such as eco-sensitive zones and coastal area management, with a strong emphasis on environmental justice and its application across various levels. By integrating both theoretical frameworks and practical skills, students gain the tools needed for effective engagement in this specialized field of law. Additionally, the course addresses climate law and litigation to deepen its practical relevance.

Delivered through offline teaching, the course employs methods such as PowerPoint presentations, short video clips, and guided reflections on pre-selected topics. Each lecture concludes with discussions to encourage student interaction and engagement with the material. Select students are also assigned project topics to foster deeper involvement and strategic thinking.

Overall, the course is designed to equip students with a thorough understanding of environmental law, combining theoretical insights with practical skills for real-world application.
